What is UTT

- - Technology transfer office systematically promotes entrepreneurship, promotes and supports transfer of knowledge and research results from University to the economy.
- - Aim of the Technology transfer office is to become a meeting point between University and economy and to increase, with its activities, the commercialization of University's intellectual property.

Official opening

-- Technology transfer office was officially opened on May 08, 2007 at Second Congress of Croatian Scientist from the homeland and Abroad. The office was opened by Saarland state secretary dr. sc. Christian Ege.

Office supports researches in all stages of technology implementation: from idea, invention, process of intellectual property protection, to setting up a company and commercialization of intellectual property.

Following activities

INNOVATION POLICY

First draft expected soon, points to be included:

- - who is the owner of IP (faculty or university)?
- - at which faculties elements of IP policy exist (e.g. Uni-Zagreb)?
- - analysis of existing IP regulations at faculties (questionnaire for vice-deans)
- - identifying PhD students that have interests and potentials for entrepreneurial activities
- - suggestion: professors (from assistant professor to tenure full professor) can take a sabbatical or one “free” year for spin-off/in?
- - what is a status of professors-entrepreneurs at the universities?
- - existing models in other countries
- - include ministries (MZOS, MF, MGRP), universities, research institutes, HGK, --HUP, AZVO, UKF, BICRO, HIT, etc.
- - proposal for technology audit

Following activities

- - Training for students and staff
- - Business plan competition (fall 2007)
- - Database of researchers interested in cooperation with companies
 - - Includes data on subjects in which a scientist can act as a consultant and types of analyses and equipment to be found in his/hers lab
- - Newsletter on technology outbreaks and office news (4 times a year)
- - Participation in development of IP policy of the University IPR documents (different forms and instructions)

Transfer tehnologije

Transfer tehnologije je proces pri kojem se izum ili intelektualno vlasništvo, proizvedeno iz znanstvenih istraživanja, procjenjuje se njegova komercijalna vrijednost te se licencira gospodarstvu koje ga stavlja na tržište. Transfer tehnologije služi se kao komercijalizacija zuma koji je nastao kao rezultat istraživačkog rada.
